Concrete with or without rebar, Concrete Chunks 2ft in diameter or below, & Concrete Washout	Eagle County C&D Diversion (970)328-3470 ext 1	•You must contact the facility for approval PRIOR to hauling a load. •Check for asbestos. •Save \$42/ton by recycling.

CLEAN WOOD WASTE

Clean Dimensional Lumber Unpainted & Untreated	Eagle County C&D Diversion	•No treated wood, no adhesives, no painted lumber. •Scrap studs are accepted. •Save \$42/ton by recycling. •You must contact the landfill for approval PRIOR to hauling.

Copper, Aluminum, Brass, Steel, Iron, & Stainless Steel	Trinity Recycling (970) 328-5051	•Get paid for scrap metal. •Call ahead to confirm accepted items.
